National Priorities (1)

◆ **Drug trafficking**

- ◆ Increase the effectiveness of Greek authorities, Reinforced Cooperation with other M-S and Agencies

◆ **Trafficking in Human Beings (THB)**

- ◆ Effective prevention of THB,
- ◆ Improvement relevant mechanisms
- ◆ Enhanced Cooperation and Training

◆ **Anti-corruption policy** (in particular in public procurement procedures)

- ◆ A roadmap of fighting against corruption
- ◆ Implement a reliable Public Procurement Reform Strategy

National Priorities (2)

- ◆ Develop **financial investigation in all serious and organized crime cases** to: dismantle criminal networks, provide prosecutable evidence before the judge, develop monitoring and detection tools and trace criminal assets
- ◆ Access to an exchanging information platform for the acquisition of shared information among the cooperating Offices, such as banking institutions, agencies from all Ministries involved
- ◆ Develop and Deployment of an information system –
 - ◆ Analyze the crime activity data
 - ◆ Spatial Analysis Tools, GIS
 - ◆ Mapping crime activity clumps by street, neighborhood or larger geographic areas

National Priorities (3)

- ◆ Weak implementation of information exchange mechanisms (**Prum Decision**) and **Swedish Initiative**.
 - ◆ Achieve full compatibility of the Greek Database “Online vehicle registration System” with EUCARIS System for the exchange of VRD via automated searching.
- ◆ Improve capabilities in the **fight against cybercrime** at national level and contribute to improvement at EU level
 - ◆ Procurement of specialized equipment and software, so as to combat various forms of Cybercrime
 - ◆ Development of a National Cyber Security Strategy towards highlighting the importance of ICTs to the nation, identifying and evaluating potential risks and threats
 - ◆ Active participation to the European Cybercrime Centre at Europol (EC3) and establishment of a national cyber-crime center

National Priorities (4)

- ◆ Radicalisation towards **terrorism** and **violent extremism**
- ◆ Establish partnerships and platforms for knowledge and exchange of information and experience between practitioners and stakeholders, based on the experience of the **Radicalisation Awareness Network (RAN)**.
- ◆ Establish a **Greek national Contact Point** as part of the RAN. This single PoC will unify the efforts of various actors in Greece (Government, Universities, practitioners, experts, NGOs etc.) for harmonizing radicalization in Greece within the RAN framework

National Priorities (5)

- ◆ **Protection of National Critical Infrastructures**
 - ◆ Strengthen administrative and operational capability to protect critical assets.
 - ◆ Increase security capabilities specific to terrorist crises in view to enhance preparedness and response capabilities in case of terrorist attacks to critical infrastructures.
 - ◆ Maintain a high level of societal resilience and increase preparedness through advanced risk assessment.
- ◆ **EU policy cycle on serious and organised crime - participation of Greece**

National Priorities (6)

- ◆ Use modern technology at the borders (“**Smart Borders**”) – **Complementarity with Research and Innovation**
 - ◆ Establish an advanced **Automated Border Control System (ABCs)**
 - ◆ Feasibility study implementation for the creation of a valid Investment Plan for all border control points of Greece that will take into account a multitude of factors.
 - ◆ Investment leading to use of **interoperable modern technologies** in line with European standards. For example ABC gates for EU citizens should also be able to be used for the future **Registered Traveller Programme (RTP)** component of the smart borders initiative, by implementing fingerprint readers.

Internal Security Fund – Principle of Complementarity

- ◆ EU Budget : Greece will have approximately 20 million Euro for the whole period 2014-2020
 - ◆ **Center for Security Studies** has an **Active Role** in the **implementation process.**
- ◆ **Need of Complementarity with other Financial Instruments**
- ◆ Close Cooperation with **Center for Security Studies** in the field of Research and Innovation
